SUBJECT: What legal rules should apply to couples living together not being married, as well between themselves as toward their common children?

## QUESTIONNAIRE:

1.-Does your legal system draw any consequences from the fact that a couple lives together not being married?

How long shall a concubinage last to produce legal consequences ?

2.- Can a leaseholder authorize another person to cohabit in the dwelling house without the permit of the lessor?

- 7. In case of habitual cohabitation without marriage, are there any consequences as regards social security or public assistance (e.g.:benefits for non married mothers)?

8.- Is a survivor's pension modified when a widow (or widower) forms a new family of fact?

- 9.- Are the goods of one partner covered by an insurance contract stipulate by the other partner?
- 10. Can a non married couple adopt a child jointly ?
  - 11. What is the situation in case of dissolution of a marriage of fact, either for dissent or for/death of one of the partners?
    - a) How shall jointly purchased and paid goods be shared by partners?
    - b) Has each partner the right to continue a lease of an apartment, when the contract was stipulated by the other partner in his own name?
    - c) If common children exist, is access assured to the parent who does not have legal custody of them?
    - d) What surname is given to the common children?
    - e) If no will exists, has each partner a right of succession to the other
    - f) In case of separation of partners, if common goods are shared, shall one take into account the fact that one of the partners has contribut to household expenses with his work?
- 12. When one of the non married partners dies in consequence of a fatal accident, can the other partner claim compensation for damages?
  - 13.- As regards the duty to testify in civil proceedings, has each partner of a non married couple the same right of abstention as a husband or wife would have?
