Subject: "A Comparison of the law and practical working in each member State of the relationship or conflict between work establishment, trade unions and employers."

- I.a) Does there exist a fundamental right for freedom of associations (trade unions)?
 - b) Organisation of the trade unions (whole country, certain districts, branches of industries)?
 - c) Which means and protections have they got and which restrictions exist?
- II.a) Organisation of workers representation works council (level of a single undertaking or a whole enterprise; election; period)?
 - b) Is the works council a part of trade union or is it organised separately?
 - c) Does the works council represent all workers of the undertaking (enterprise)?
 - d) Which are the main competences of a works council?
- e) Is the works council entitled to conclude works agreements (which items?) and which effect do they have on
 - 1. the working contract and
 - 2. tariff agreements of the trade unions?
- III.a) Contracting partners of tariff agreements?
 - b) Which matters can be regulated in tariff agreements?
 - c) The working relationship of which employees and employers are ruled by a certain tariff agreement?
 - d) What are the effects of these tariff agreements?
 - 1. Are these standards binding for some or all employers?
 - 2. Are these standards only binding if the working contract refers to them?
 - 3. Are these standards only minimum standards?
- IV. What limitations are put on the trade unions?

 Do trade unions have a duty to employers?
- V. When conflicts arise, how are they resolved (procedure, competence)?
