A DIFFERENT APPROACH TO ORGANISED CRIME

- New investigative measures;
- gathering of evidence;

Notes:

- 1) the answers must be based exclusively upon the existing legislation, or the new laws in preparation, as well as the jurisdiction of the participating countries;*
- 2) next to the aspect “organised crime” it would be very important to know the reaction in your countries to the “new terrorism” which has become a part of our actuality since september 2001. I would appreciate it if you could send me the texts of new legislative measures (either as complete new laws or as amendations of the pre-existing ones). They could be published by the Foundation Justice in the World and serve as a very useful working instruments for all of us;*
- 3) particular aspects of the international collaboration concerning this “new terrorism”: bi- or multilateral agreements, inter- or supranational measures, respect for the human rights.*
