Conclusions

COMPULSORY ENFORCEMENT OF JUDGEMENTS

In the interest of all who seek justice and in order to preserve respect for decisions taken by independent judicial authorities, states should take steps to assure the proper means of forced execution of judgments.

States should take steps in order to facilitate the recovery of alimentary payments in favor of minors for example by governmental agencies advancing the sums ordered by the judgment.

When judgment is given against the state or public authorities, they should comply forthwith.
